

Knitting patterns

NEEDLES: Nr. 4mm

WOOL: Double knit

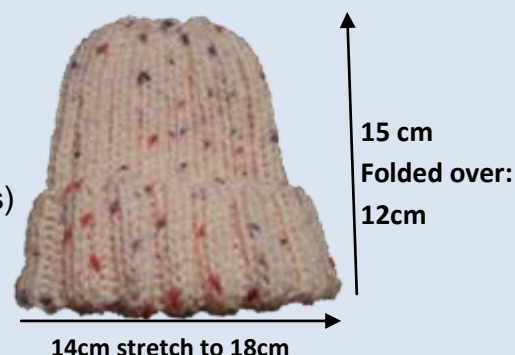
Cast on 62 stiches.

It is not necessary to use this specific wool, it is just the wool used in the example.

Preferably, the wool should be soft and stretchy so that it does not irritate the baby's sensitive skin.

BEANIE: the example is folded over at the bottom

1. Using 4mm needles, cast on 62 stitches.
2. Knit Rib, k2, p2 until work measures 13cm.
3. With wrong side facing – p2 k2tog, repeat last 2sts, p2 (47sts)
4. K2, p1 – repeat to last 2sts, k2.
5. P2tog, k1 – repeat to last 2sts, p2tog (31sts).
6. K1, p1 – repeat to last st, k1.
7. K1, k2tog, repeat to last st, k1 (21sts).



Cut yarn 30cm long. Using a darning needle, thread through remaining stitches.

Pull stitches into a tight circle.

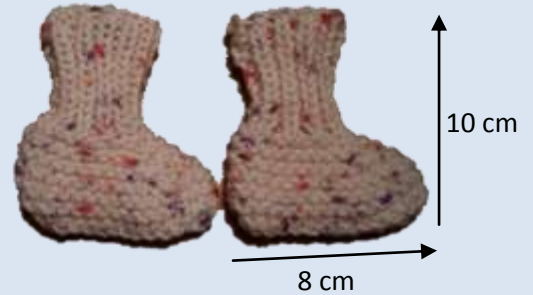
Sew down back seam.

SOCKS:

Using 4mm needles, cast on 31 stitches.

1. Knit 6 rows garter stitch.
2. K12 sts, k2tog, k3, k2tog, k12.
3. K11 sts, k2tog, k3, k2tog, k11.
4. K10 sts, k2tog, k3, k2tog, k10.
5. K9 sts, k2tog, k3, k2tog, k9.
6. K8 sts, k2tog, k3, k2tog, k8.
7. With 21 sts remaining: Knit 14 rows rib, k1, p1.
8. Cast off loosely. Sew seam at back and bottom.

Thank you for threading the beanie and socks together.



ABBREVIATIONS

k	Knit
p	Purl
k2tog	Knit two stitches together
p2tog	Pull together
sts	Stitches
